Charging of ground rent.

Vide this office Circular No. D-9/DR-C/123, J-1 of 1986-87 dated 22nd Sept. 1986, the rate of ground rent to be charged on timber, fuelwood, long bamboo and charcoal, in case of grant of extension in time for removal of material beyond the period of 90 days, computed from the date of auction/date of communication of acceptances by the competent authority, but limited to a maximum of 180 days, were prescribed.

2.0 It has come to the notice of this office that in absence of the prescribed rate of ground rent to be charged for bamboo bundles, different rates of ground rent are being levied in different Forest Circles. To bring uniformity in this respect, it is directed that the ground rent for bamboo bundles should be calculated at the following rates:-

Sr.No.	Item	Rate of ground rent
1.	Bamboo bundles	Rs.33/- per 100 bamboo bundles, each bamboo bundle containing 20 pieces of 2 mtrs length each, i.e. for 2 Notional Tons per month.
2.	Bamboo bundles	Rs.16.50 per 100 bamboo bundles, each bamboo bundle containing 20 pieces of 1 mtr. length each, i.e. for 1 Notional Ton per month.

- Note :- (A) The ground rent should be recovered on the balance quantity lying in the depot.
(B) Quantity less than 100 bamboo bundles should be reckoned as 100 bamboo bundles for the purpose of recovery of ground rent.
(C) The ground rent should be recovered for a minimum period of 1 month. The period less than 30/31 days should be reckoned as 1 month.

3.0 These rates will come into force with immediate effect.
