RESOLUTION: For some time past, the Forest Labourers Cooperative Societies had represented to Government, that as the Societies had to incur much higher expenditure on travelling and incidental expenses than admissible at present at Rs.600/- per Society, owing to general increase in price index since 1978 when this limit of Rs.600/- was sanctioned by Government, the same may be suitably enhanced. The matter was examined by Government in all its aspects, at the meeting held on 22nd June, 1983 under the Chairmanship of the Minister of Finance (when other matters too pertaining to the Forest Labourers' Cooperative Societies were considered) when it was agreed, that the expenditure admissible to each Forest Labourers' Cooperative Society, on travelling may be increased from Rs.600/- to Rs.1,000/- on the same conditions.

2. Government is accordingly pleased to direct, that the expenditure admissible to the Forest Labourers' Cooperative Societies on travelling (vide Item No.23 of the Schedule accompanying Government Resolution, Agriculture & Forests Department No.FLC-1058/111123-E(11) dated 3rd December 1959 as amended by Government Resolutions, cited at Sr.Nos. (11) and (11i) supra) be enhanced

from Rs. 600/- to Rs. 1,000/- per Society or limited to actual expenditure which ever is less, subject to the condition that the Society should observe due economy in this regard and the Secretary of the Society should visit the coupes worked by the Forest Labourers' Cooperative Societies at least twice a week. In case, this frequency of visits is not adhered to, the amount of Travelling Allowance should be proportionately reduced.

3. These orders should take effect in respect of the coupes allotted to the Forest Labourers' Cooperative Societies from the Working Year 1983-84 onwards.

4. This Government Resolution issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department (vide its un-official reference No. CR-811/83/EXP-10, dated 29th July, 1983).
