INDIAN FORESTS ACT, 1927 AND BOMBAY FOREST RULES, 1942.

No. TRS. 1095/CR-34/F-6.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 41 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 (XVI of 1927), in its application to the State of Maharashtra, read with clause (c) of the Proviso to rule 66 of the Bombay Forest Rules, 1942; and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Maharashtra hereby exempts transport of "Ashok (*Polyalthia longifolia*), Drumstick (*Moringa Oleifera*), Sindi (*Phoenix Sylvestris*), Orange (*Citrusaurantium*), Chiku (*Achras Zapota*), Bhendi (*Thespesia Populnea*), Acacia (*Acacia manglum*) and Poplar (*Populus*)" trees or parts thereof from the operation of the said rules.
