Subject: i. Acceptance of offers below the sanctioned upset prices.

REFERENCE:

In the Senior Forest Officer's Conference held from 4th to 8th September, 1972, the subject (No. 30) acceptance of offers below the sanctioned upset price was discussed. In this respect the following executive orders were issued for guidance:-

In case of Sale of Forest Produce, if the offer received either in open auction or in tender, is less than the sanctioned upset price and if in the opinion of the Divisional Forest Officer, there is no likelihood of getting any more price in future, the Divisional Forest Officer concerned may accept the offer on S.S. Form taking into account the merits of the case. The Divisional Forest Officer will then refer the matter to the Conservator of Forests concerned, giving full justification for recommending the acceptance of sale at the price less than the sanctioned upset price. The Conservator of Forests concerned will then issue necessary orders within the stipulated period about the acceptance or otherwise of the offer. This may kindly be brought to the notice of all the Divisional Forest Officers.
