RESOLUTION

Govt. has been considering the issue of an <sup>ombibus</sup> Govt. Resolution regarding the supply of teak and other hardwood species like ain, haldu, sissam etc. to Govt. Dep'tts. and certain parties at pre-determined rates without auction for the personal use of the said deptt. and parties. Govt. is now pleased to direct, in supersession of all previous orders that the DFOs and the independent Sub-DFOs may supply, subject to availability and prior commitment, teak and other hardwood species to the parties mentioned below at scheduled rates plus 10%. Any taxes or fees payable shall be in addition.

Parties to whom teak/hardwood may be supplied :

- i) All Dep'tts. of the State Govt.,
- ii) All Corporations owned wholly by the State Govt.,
- iii) All Dep'tts. of the Govt. of India including Director General of Civil Supplies, Posts and Telegraphs Railways
- iv) Statutory Corporations and authorities of State Govt. such as Maharashtra State Road Corporation, M.S. Electricity Board, Maharashtra Housing Board.
- v) Colleges, Schools, Libraries and Hospitals registered under the Societies Registration Act and the Public Trusts Act,
- vi) Municipal Corporations, Municipal Councils, Zilla Parishads and Village Panchayats in the State.
- vii) Cooperative Societies registered under the Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act.

2. The aforesaid parties shall not be entitled to the supply unless the requirement at one time exceeds Rs.3,000/- in value. Nor shall it be supplied if the material is to be delivered by an entitled party to a contractor unless there is an express stipulation in the contract imposing an obligation on the entitled applicant to supply the material.

3. The scheduled rates shall be deemed to be the rates fixed by the C.C.F. from time to time as representing approximately the price which would have been realised if the material has been sold by auction/tender. For this purpose, the C.C.F. should fix the scheduled rates for each species and grade for each Depot and ensure that the rates are revised at least once in 3 years. In case the C.C.F. has not fixed the scheduled rate in respect of any item or for the specification desired or for any area or the period for which the same having been fixed has expired, the DFO/Ind. Sub-DFO shall be competent to determine the scheduled rate for the teak/hardwood desired on the basis indicated above.

4. Every applicant desiring to obtain teak or any other hardwood species in accordance with these orders shall make an application in the form attached along with the certificate in common

5. On receiving the application in the prescribed form complete in all respects, the D.F.O./Ind. Sub.D.F.O. must scrutinise eligibility of the applicant. In case he is satisfied about the eligibility, he should ascertain the availability and inform the applicant about the amount to be paid and the likely place of delivery and request the applicant to pay the same within 15 days. After the full payment is made, the material will be segregated as and when available and the applicant informed to collect the same. If full

full payment is not received within 15 days, the case will be closed. The applicant shall in no circumstances be allowed to select the material so long as it concerns broadly to the specifications.
