RESOLUTION

The Maharashtra Felling of Trees(Regulation)Act, 1964 has come into force in this State with effect from 7th September,1964 so far, following eleven species of trees have been included in the schedule appended to the said Act.

- i) Hirda,
- ii) Teak,
- iii) Mahuwa
- iv) Tamrind
- v) Mango —
- vi) Jack —
- vii) Khair
- viii) Sandal,
- ix) Bija
- x) Haldu
- xi) Tiwas.

According to section 25 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, 1966 rights over all trees(including reserved trees) standing or growing on any occupied land have been conceded to the occupants. It has been brought to the notice of Government that Ain, Kindal, Anjan and Jambhul trees are valuable species of trees and they need to be preserved. In the circumstances, it has become necessary to include the above trees in the Schedule appended to the Maharashtra Felling of Trees(Regulation) Act, 1964 so as to restrict felling of those trees. Government is accordingly pleased to direct that the*appended Government Notification should be published in Part IV-B of the Maharashtra Government Gazette extraordinary, dated 16th January, 1976.

2. The Director of Languages, Maharashtra State, Bombay should immediately make arrangements to translate the Notification into Marathi and Hindi(Devnagri) and send the translation to the Manager, Government Central Press for publication in the Maharashtra Government Gazette by 1st February, 1976, at the latest.

3. The Manager, Government Central Press should print copies of the Notification in English, Marathi and Hindi in the Maharashtra Government Gazette and to supply them to the Commissioners of Bombay, Poona, Aurangabad and Nagpur Divisions and the Collectors in the said Divisions and the other Offices/ Officers in accordance with the*appended distribution list. He should also keep sufficient number of copies of the Notification in English, Marathi and Hindi to meet further official requirement and for sale to public.

5. The cost of printing the Notification should for the purposes of press proforma account be debited to the budget head "229-Land Revenue".
