RESOLUTION

The Maharashtra Felling of Trees(Regulation)Act, 1964 has come into force in this State with effect from 7th September,1964, So far , the following species of trees have been included in the schedule appended to the said Act:-

- (i) Hirda (ii) Teak (iii) Mahua (iv) ~~Mx~~ Tamrind
(v) Mango(except raywal mango trees which have ceased to bear fruits) (vi) Jack(except trees which have ceased to bear fruits)(vii) ~~Khair~~(viii) ~~Sandal~~
(ix) Bija (x) Haldi (xi) Tiwas (xii) Anjan (xiii) ~~Jambhul~~

According to section 25 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, 1966 rights over all trees (including reserved trees) standing or growing on any occupied land have been conceded to the occupants. It has been brought to the notice of Government that there is indiscriminate cutting of raywal variety of mango trees and jack trees, which had ceased to bear fruits, ~~X species~~ and they need to be preserved. In the circumstances, it has become necessary to include these trees in the Schedule appended to the Maharashtra Felling of Trees(Regulation) ~~X~~ Act, 1964 so as to restrict felling of those trees. Government is accordingly pleased to direct that the * appended Government Notification should be published in Part IV-B of the Maharashtra Government Gazette extraordinary, dated 9th January 1981.


2. The Director of Languages, Maharashtra State, Bombay should immediately make arrangements to translate the Notification into Marathi and Hindi(Devnagri) and send the translation to the Manager, Government Central Press for publication in the Maharashtra Government Gazette by 20th January 1981, at the latest.

3. The Manager, Government Central Press should print copies of the Notification in English, Marathi and Hindi in the Maharashtra Government Gazette and supply them to the Commissioners of the Divisions and the Collectors in the said Divisions and the other Offices/Officers in accordance with the *appended distribution list. He should also keep sufficient number of copies of the Notification in English, Marathi and Hindi to meet further official requirement and for sale to public.


Maharashtra

No. TRS-1080/36954/929-G-7, -In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (f) of section 2 of the Maharashtra Felling of Trees (Regulation) Act, 1964 (Mah. XXXIV of 1964), the Government of Maharashtra, after having considered the necessity for the protection of the trees known as *Mangifera Indica* (Mango) and *Artocarpus Integrifolia* (Jack) specified in the Schedule to the said Act, hereby modifies the said Schedule as follows, namely:-

In the said Schedule, for entries 5 and 6, the following entries shall be respectively substituted, namely:-

- "5. MANGIFERA INDICA (Mango)
6. ARTOCARPUS INTEGRIFOLIA (Jack)."
