Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 No. WLP-1003/CR-202/F-1.- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (d) of sub-section (2) of section 64 of Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 (53 of 1972), the Government of Maharashtra hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Wild Life (Protection)(Maharashtra) Rules 1975, as follows namely:-

- These rules may be called the Wild Life (Protection)
 (Maharashtra) (Amendment) Rules, 2004.
- 2. In place of existing rule 37 of the of Wild Life (Protection) (Maharashtra) Rules, 1975 (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Rules"), the following shall be substituted namely:-
- " 37 Certificate of ownership The Chief Wildlife Warden may, for the purpose of section 40-A, issue a Registration Book for Ownership Certificate in form No. XX A to a person who in his opinion is in lawful possession of any wild animal, animal article, trophy or uncured trophy."
- In place of existing "Form XX" appended to the principal rules, "Form XX-A" shall be substituted.
