**2.1) Details of Tender Fee and Earnest Money:-** The Tenderer shall pay Rs. 2000/- as a tender fee through net banking. The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) for this work will be Rs. 5000/- (Rs. Five Thousand only) for each site and it shall have to be paid by way of Net Banking. The earnest money of unsuccessful Tenderers will be refunded online.

**2.2) Details of Security Deposit:-** The successful Tenderer shall have to pay 5% of total cost of consultancy services as security deposit. An amount equivalent to 5% of the contract value shall be retained at the end of the contract for accuracy of project preparation and necessary assistance to the office of the Dy. Conservator of Forest, Amravati Division. The security deposit will be refundable after completion of the work and completion of final deliverable that is preparation of a Detailed Project Report (DPR) that will include concept plans, designs and detailed estimates of the tasks given in the TOR and providing assistance in subsequent stages of preparation and evaluation of tender document for execution of approved works and in supervising their implementation and certification after completion of the works, without interest, if the performance of consultancy services is satisfactory. ### 2.3) Pre-Qualification and Eligibility Criteria.

E tenders are invited from eligible reputed Organization /Institutions/ Consultancy firms/Companies and Consortiums for appointment of Technical advisor(s) cum consultant(s) preferably with large area of operations and having extensive experience and expertise in Forest Infrastructure development, Ecotourism & activities related to nature and wildlife conservation for preparation of a Detailed Project Report (DPR) that will include concept plans, designs and detailed estimates of the tasks given in the TOR and providing assistance in subsequent stages of preparation and evaluation of tender documents for execution of approved works and in supervising their implementation and certification after completion of the works.

- a) The tenderer should have worked on at least One Governments/ Semi Government /Government undertaking organizations.
- b) The bidder preferably should have previous experience of executing such projects.
- c) The proposed concepts should be in consonance with the provisions of Indian Forest Act 1927, Indian Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972, Forest Conservation Act 1980, Maharashtra state Eco-tourism Policy and other related Acts, Policies and Rules.

Only those tenderers who have fulfilled the requirements as specified in the Envelope A-shall be eligible, to be called for presentation regarding the vision and Conceptual Overview fo the Forest Infrastructure development, Ecotourism & activities related to nature and wild life conservation works. After presentation all the eligible offers received will be scrutinized by the tender committee Amravati Circle on the basis of criteria mentioned in section 3.2 of chapter 3. ### 3.3) Opening and Evaluation of Financial Proposal:

**A)** The Tenderers who secure more than or equal to 65% marks in the Technical Proposal shall only qualify for consideration of opening of financial proposal.

#### **B) Evaluation of Financial Proposal**

These who will secure above 60 % can be empanelled for ecotourism projects in Amravati Division.

**3.4 Conditional Offer:-** Conditional offer shall not be accepted. Documents submitted with E TENDER will not be returned to the Tenderer. The Tender Committee Amravati Circle reserves the right to ask for hard copies or originals as required.

**3.5) Rejection of Bid:-** The right to reject all or any of the offers without assigning any reason, whatsoever, is reserved with the competent authority.

**3.6) Competent Authority:-** The tender committee Amravati Circle followed by final approval of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Nagpur shall be the competent authority.

**3.7) Agreement:-** The Tenderer shall have to enter into an agreement as per perform enclosed on the receipt of acceptance of the offer and shall abide by all the rules and regulations embodied therein and pay the performance security deposit as shown in the schedule, failing which the Dy. 2. The detailed notice inviting E TENDER along with the corrigendum etc. shall form part of the E TENDER document.

3. Any Charges, fees etc. to be paid to any agency an any approvals required from any agency for carrying out the work shall be obtained by the Technical advisor (s) cum consultant (s) at his cost.

**3.9) No Disclosure of Information:-** Information relating to evaluation of Proposals and recommendations concerning awards shall not be disclosed to the tenderers who submitted the proposals or to other persons not officially concerned with the process, until the publication of the award of contract. ### **3.10 Site Constraints**

The tenderers shall familiarize themselves with the site constraints and accordingly fill their offer considering all the hurdles likely to be faced during work

### **3.11 Right to Split/ Amalgamate the work**

Dy. Conservator of Forests, Amravati Division, Amravati reserves the right to split/amalgamate the work and /or change the location if required, into suitable parts and allocate the work in parts to different agencies. Under these circumstances, the amount shall be proportionately apportioned. The tenderer shall indemnify Dy. Conservator of Forest Amravati Division Amravati for this splitting or amalgamate done by him

### **3.12 Correction of any computational errors**

The evaluation committee will correct any computational errors, in case of discrepancy between a partial amount and the total amount or between words and figures the former will prevail. In case an activity or line item is quantified in the financial proposal differently from the technical proposal it will have to be clarified in writing by the applicants. The evaluation committee shall correct the quantification indicated in the financial proposal so as to make it consistent with that indicated in the technical proposal, apply the relevant unit price included in the financial proposal in this respect.

### **3.13 Negotiation**

There shall be no scope for any negotiation related to the technical or financial quotes with any of the tenderer including the tenderer who has quoted the lowest.
