Circular :-

In view to provide facility to applicants to fill up form as per his convenience from his home or office & to avoid need of physically visiting to the Forest Office, Forest Department has developed an online system which is operative from April, 2017. The instructions to use this system were already issued vide Government Resolutions under reference No. (1).

It a mandateory that all the applicantiions for Tree felling and Tree Transit pass for Industrial and Commercial purpose should be submitted online. In any case no offline application shall be processed.

In view of above, it is directed that, tree felling/transit pass applications for Industrial and Commercial purpose shall be accepted & processed through online system only. Physical copy shall not be asked from the applicant. If applicant faces any difficulty in filling online form, concerned officer will help him to upload the same but in any case physical copies will not be accepted.

The status of the applicant's application is to be updated by concerned officer at various level through online system only. No manual processing of the applications of tree felling/ transit pass applications for Industrial and Commercial purpose shall be allowed.
